CAREER EDUCATION ELECTIVES & TECHNOLOGY

COMPUTER SERVICES AND REPAIR (1/2 year) is a course designed for students with limited or no PC experience. The course will explore the components of a computer, troubleshooting techniques, and repair procedures.

COMPUTER SYSTEMS teaches practical computer system skills incorporating programming and application software.

COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY & APPLICATIONS is a course, which provides the students with a strong working knowledge of computer hardware and an integrated software package.

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY (1/2 year) is a course designed to teach introductory digital photography.

INFORMATION PROCESSING 1 is a course designed to prepare students to use a computer to perform word processing.

INTRO TO TV BROADCASTING (1/2 year) is an English course designed for the general track student to explore broadcasting from all aspects, focusing on the role of broadcasting news, writing, and production.

CONSUMER EDUCATION (1/2 year) is a course that teaches students how to manage personal finances, understand economics, and utilize computer software.

PERSONAL INFORMATION PROCESSING (1/2 year) is a course designed to provide students with keyboarding and word processing skills necessary for personal and business use.

TECHNICAL LIFE SKILLS is an introductory course designed to provide students with a better understanding of basic computer skills, career awareness and career path development, money management, and interpersonal communication skills.

TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION 1 is an introductory course that explores and explains technology of the 21st century. Electronics, computers, telecommunications, project development, research, careers, and engineering will be explored. Students will also design and build model bridges, aerodynamic cars, and other tasks to practically display how technology assists our society.

TV BROADCASTING 1 is an elective English course designed to explore broadcasting from all aspects, focusing on the role of broadcasting news, writing, and production.

FINE/VISUAL & PERFORMING ARTS

ADVANCED CHOIR is a performance oriented choir course. Enrollment is by audition only.

ART FOUNDATION 1 is an entry-level course for the High School Visual Arts Curriculum. It is designed to provide an overview of visual arts while studying a broad variety of art tools and materials.

CLASS PIANO introduces beginners to basic piano study, and also provides no-cost sessions to students with previous keyboard skills.

CONCERT CHOIR is a performance oriented full year course.

HISTORY OF ROCK-N-ROLL(1/2 year) is a course that focuses on the development of popular music in America, beginning with the popular standards of the 30s and 40s, to the birth of Rock and Roll in the 1950s and its continued metamorphosis into the 21st century.

INTRO TO THEATER SURVEY (1/2 year) is a course designed for the general track student which will expose students to the performance, technical, and literary aspects of Theatre Arts.

MUSIC A-Z (1/2 year) is a course that serves as an introduction to music theory and music appreciation, providing students with a background in music basics.

SYMPHONIC BAND is a performance oriented full-year course, which consists of sight-reading, repertoire exposure, symphonic band literature and symphonic literature development.

THEATRE SURVEY will expose students to the performance, technical, and literary aspects of Theatre Arts.

TOB/WIND is a performance oriented full year course, which consists of marching band and symphonic band.
